### **New National Restrictions from 5 November**

As you will be aware, a national lockdown across England will come into force at 00.01 tomorrow, Thursday 5 November.

The new restrictions advise that schools, colleges and universities should remain open and under this guidance, West Lancashire College, along with all NCG colleges, will remain open for students and Apprentices throughout the lockdown period.


If you believe that your son/daughter are 'clinically extremely vulnerable' as defined by the [government guidance](#), and therefore are or will be in receipt of a doctor's letter to confirm this, we are asking that they study from home during the next four weeks. If your son/daughter is in this category and have not yet had a conversation with their tutor or assessor, please could you ensure they arrange this as a matter of urgency so that support can be put in place during this period so that they do not fall behind.

Please remember that our campus remains Covid-secure and we have extensive safety measures in place to ensure the health and safety of our, students, Apprentices and staff on campus.

As always, this is a constantly evolving situation and we expect that guidance for colleges will change over the coming days and weeks. We will continue to bring you updates as and when we receive them.
