







Level 3 Entitlement Information

If you're aged 19-23 and do not already hold a full Level 3 qualification, the adult education budget offers you the entitlement to funding for your course.

At West Lancashire College, you can choose from the following Level 3 courses (subject to availability and eligibility); Access to University, Access to Medical Science, Access to Nursing & Midwifery, Access to Health & Social Wellbeing, Art & Design, Beauty Therapy, Business, Children's Care, Computing & IT, Electrical Installation, Engineering, Hairdressing, Health & Social Care, Performing Arts, Public Services and Sports.

Please note: to take advantage of the Level 3 entitlement you must be aged 19-23 on 31 August 2020 and have not previously completed a full level 3 qualification.

ADULT FUNDING CHANGES

Due to changes in Government funding, from 1st August 2019 learners resident in some postcodes (Merseyside and Greater Manchester) may be unable to access funding from training providers and colleges in Lancashire and may have to pay all associated course and support costs.
