## Terms and Conditions

Students should clearly identify themselves to the bus driver if they wish for the bus to stop and pick them up. Bus driver may change regularly, so this is essential everyday practice to ensure the bus stops. Learner must show their College ID Badge to the driver on their first journey. Learners will not be allowed onto the bus without their College ID Badge.

Students are expected to treat the bus drivers with respect and courtesy. Bad manners or behaviour will result in exclusion from the free College bus service. No food or drink should be consumed on the bus and students are expected to remove all rubbish or litter that they may create during the journey to and from college.
