Terms & Conditions:

Students should clearly identify themselves to the bus driver if they wish the bus to stop and pick up. Bus drivers may change regularly, so this is essential every day practice to ensure the bus stops for you.

Learners must show their College ID Badge to the driver on their first journey - learners will not be allowed onto the bus without their College ID Badge. **Once you start college please call to Learner Services to register for your College Service Pass.**

Students are expected to treat the bus drivers with respect and courtesy – bad manners or behaviour will result in exclusion from the free College bus service.

No food or drink should be consumed on the College bus and students are expected to remove all rubbish or litter they may create during the journey to and from college.

In the event of adverse weather conditions, students should check the College website prior to leaving home.
