Teacher Assessed Grades (TAGs)

The government has said that many exams and assessments cannot be held fairly this year as a result of the disruption students have faced due to the pandemic.

Therefore, the majority of students studying A Levels, BTECs and GCSEs will receive Teacher Assessed Grades (TAGs).

If you are studying one of the above qualifications, your tutor will meet with you over the next few weeks to agree a basket of evidence that your final TAG Grade will be based on and will submit your grades to the exam boards, based on their assessment of what you have shown you know and can do, enabling you to progress to the next stage of your education, training, or employment.
