Many of our courses are funded\* or have no upfront costs. The cost of your course depends on your individual circumstance and there are lots of funding opportunities available to help pay for your course. If you do have to pay for your course you could spread the payments with our instalment plan, or if you are over 19 studying a Level 3 qualification you may be able to apply for an Advanced Learning Loan meaning you buy now pay later. If you live outside of Lancashire, due to recent changes in Government funding you will be eligible to pay the full course fee and all associated support costs (funding may be available to those living in Liverpool City Region). This will be discussed with you at your enrolment appointment; payment instalments are available.

*\*In the response to the DfE consultation Skills for jobs: implementing a new further education funding and accountability system, the College receives Education Skills Funding Agency [ESFA] adult skills fund [ASF] for us to support adult learners in non-devolved areas to gain skills which will lead them to meaningful, sustained, and relevant employment, or enable them to progress to further learning which will deliver that outcome. Within ASF, further provision for tailored learning is available that supports wider outcomes such as to improve health and wellbeing, equip parents/carers to support their child's learning, and develop stronger communities.*

*Additionally, the College receives funding to provide education and training for adults aged 19 and above in the Liverpool City Region. The funding enables us to engage adults and provide the learning they need to progress into or within work, or to equip them for further learning or training. This has enabled flexible, tailored programmes of learning to be delivered, helping learners engage in learning, build confidence, and enhance their wellbeing.*

# What Do I Bring to Enrolment?

## PAYMENT

We accept payment by credit or debit card. Course fees are payable at enrolment. If the annual course fee payable by you is over £200, you may be able to pay by instalments see table below (subject to agreement at enrolment). If you wish to request instalment payments, you will be required to sign a Fee Payment Agreement at enrolment if these are agreed and will also need your bank details

(account number, sort code and bank address).

If your course fee is being paid by a third party (e.g employer) you will be given the appropriate documentation at enrolment. Call 01695 52300 and ask for Learner Services to find out if you are eligible for assistance.

## FEE REFUNDS

Where the college has to cancel a course, the college will credit the fee and refund any fee payment to the learner. If the student agrees to an appropriate alternative course, then the original fee payment would be credited against the new alternative course. Students may apply to the college for a refund or partial refund of tuition fees if there are extenuating circumstances.

## ADDITIONAL COURSE RELATED COSTS

Some courses require you to purchase the appropriate kit, uniform or materials. You will be advised on how to order and costs prior to the start of the course.

## IDENTIFICATION

The Learning Records Service requires learners to verify their identity at enrolment, therefore when enrolling for your course you will need to bring original copies of one of the following documents with you.

If you enrol over the phone, you will be required to bring this identification with you to collect your ID card before you start your course.

To enrol you will be required to bring in proof of address, this can be a utility bill or bank statement. This is in addition to and support of identification evidence.

## SETTLED STATUS

Funding for Further Education courses has changed post-Brexit.

The EU Settlement Scheme is designed to offer EU, EEA and Swiss nationals and their eligible family members living in the UK, the opportunity to protect their residence and travel rights in the UK. The application is free and the process is relatively straight forward.

If you are an EU/EEA/Swiss national living in the UK and wish to study at West Lancashire College, you will be required to prove your settled or pre-settled status.

## PREVIOUS QUALIFICATIONS

If you are aged 16-18 you will need to bring proof of your GCSEs and any other qualifications. If you are aged 19+ you will need proof/knowledge of any prior qualifications and for some full-time courses such as Access to Higher Education, you will be asked to provide evidence of certification.

## NATIONAL SKILLS FUND

The National Skills Fund which is aimed to help adults gain the skills that are sought by employers. This means the government will fund a range of Level 3 qualifications for those aged 19 or over. ## I AM NOT A BRITISH OR IRISH CITIZEN, WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

The College is legally required to confirm evidence of your visa/immigration status. If you are not a British or Irish national, you must bring your Passport, travel document or Application Registration Card (ARC) card for identification purposes.

### Please bring with you:

- eVisa share code - if you can view your immigration status online using your United Kingdom Visas and Immigration account, you can use the Gov.uk website to obtain a share code. We can use the code provided to check your status. Your share code will be 9 digits and consist of letters and numbers.

If you can't get a share code, you can bring your physical original immigration documents if they are still valid (i.e. they have not expired).

### This can include one of the following:

- **Visa vignette in passport** - a visa vignette is a sticker placed in your passport that shows you have been granted permission to enter the UK for a specific purpose, such as study or work.
- **Stamp in passport** - a passport stamp is an ink mark placed in your passport by a UK Border Force officer when you arrive, showing the date and place of your entry into the country
- **Biometric Residence Permit** - Biometric Residence Permits (BRPs) are cards that were used to prove immigration status. You might have a BRP if you were granted permission to live or work in the UK on or before 31 October 2024.
- **Bail 201 letter** - a Bail 201 letter is an official document issued by the UK Home Office to individuals who have been granted immigration bail. Please also bring your Application Registration Card (ARC).

**Please note**, if you have an immigration status which is reliant on family member, e.g. dependant status, family visa, child visa, etc, you will also be required to provide the immigration documents of your family member.
