07.46am - Cambridge Road, bus stop after Cockle Dicks Lane

07.49am - Preston New Road, Southport PR9 9SB (bus stop at shops)

07.53am - Rufford Road/Preston New Road, PR9 8NE (bus stop opposite BridgeWills Lane)

07.58.am - Opposite Kinderworld, Bispham Road, PR9 7BL (bus stop Old Park Lane)

08.02am - Bus stop on Southbank, after Falkland Road, before Everard

08.19 am - Liverpool Road South Burscough – opposite Mill Dam Lane

08.21 am - Liverpool Road South - opposite Lordsgate Drive

08.23 am - Junction Lane opposite Richmond Avenue

08.26 am - Briars Lane opposite Flax Lane
