07.31am - Preston New Road, Southport, PR9 9SB. Bus stop at the shops

07.34am - Rufford Road/Preston New Road, PR9 8NE. Bus stop opposite Bridge Wills Lane

07.42am - Opposite Kinderworld, Bispham Road, PR9 7BL. Bus stop at Old Park Lane

07.47am - Bus stop on Southbank, after Falkland Road, before Everard

Terms & Conditions:
