This two-year course will provide you with all the skills and industry experience you need to kick-start your career. Learning from tutors with a background in industry and in our fantastic facilities, all whilst gaining invaluable experience through a work placement, you will learn digital skills such as programming, emerging issues and the impact of digital, as well as legislation, regulatory requirements and security.

You will also undertake an employer industry placement for a minimum of 45 days throughout your course, giving you the opportunity to put your new skills into practice and thrive in the workplace.

Entry Requirements

- You will typically require a minimum of 5 GCSEs at Grade 5 or above, including English and maths.
- You may also be required to participate in an assessment to ensure suitability ahead of enrolment.





What will I achieve?

On successful completion of this course you will achieve a Pearson Level 3 T-Level in Digital Production, Design and Development (Digital Production, Design and Development).

What will I learn?

You will study the following core modules:

- Problem solving
- Introduction to programming
- · Emerging issues and impact of digital
- Legislation and regulatory requirements
- Business context
- Data
- · Digital environments
- · Security.

You will also complete an occupational specialism component (Digital Production, Design and Development).

Alongside your studies you will undertake a substantial work experience placement of at least 45 days.

Work Experience opportunities

Work experience is an important part of your T-Level. You will undertake a substantial work placement with an employer for a minimum of 45 days during your course to help you prepare for your next steps. You will also undertake an employer-set project as part of the course.

English and maths

English, maths and digital skills are vital to all roles in digital and these are embedded throughout the course to help you prepare for working in the industry.

Where can I progress?

On successful completion of this course, you may progress into industry on an apprenticeship or into a variety of entry-level roles within the digital industry.

Students with a Level 3 T-Level in Digital Production, Design and Development (Digital Production, Design and Development) have access to a wide range of career opportunities including a Foundation Degree or higher-level study to become a digital designer or programmer, among many other roles.
